Dear Metro Tacoma Fencing Club Families and Friends,

### End of fencing season 2023-2024 update

The Paris 2024 Olympics starts in 7 days! Fencing is one of only five sports to have been featured at every modern Olympics (since 1896). The other sports are track and field, gymnastics, cycling, and swimming. We have a strong US team this year. And there will be a chance to watch some world class fencing!





Thank you to all the club members and volunteers who helped out during our club spring cleaning on June 8. We moved things around and created a larger and more open space for our fencers. We had a drawing, and Joe won the \$100 Leon Paul gift card raffle!

The 2023-2024 fencing season ended at the conclusion of the USA Fencing Summer Nationals and July Challenge that was held in Columbus, Ohio from June 29 through July 8. It was the largest USA Fencing Summer Nationals event ever with over 6,200 registered fencers. Metro Tacoma Fencing Club sent 14 fencers competing in over 43 events along with three coaches.

#### MTFC end of season 2023-2024 achievements



Gabey Guerra had an exceptional season and made it to the Cadet (U17) men's foil finals against our friend Riccardo Sisinni (Silicon Valley Fencing) at Summer Nationals. Gabey finished 2nd place by one touch earning a silver medal, his A2024 foil rating (98.6th percentile or the equivalent and difficulty of earning a black belt in martial arts), and a spot to compete in the Cadet World Circuit representing the United States this coming season. Hard work and grit pay off. Congratulations to Gabey and Coach Chung! Overall, this season we had 65 fencers represent Metro Tacoma Fencing Club in 543 events. We have 10 fencers Gabey, Harrison,

Christopher, Cristian, Benjamin, Toby, Seoheul, Li, Jaelynn, and Subin) earn national points and are thus nationally ranked. We had two fencers earn their A2024 rating in foil (Gabey and Benjamin) and three fencers earn their A2024 rating in épée (Toby, Xian Chen Bu, and Andrew). We also had one fencer earn his B2024 in foil (Christopher). Other fencers who earned or renewed their ratings included Harrison (C2024 in foil), Ephraim (E2024 in épée), Teo (C2024 in épée and D2024 in foil), Li (D2024 in foil), Jaelynn (D2024 in foil), Bryan (E2024 in épée), Pascal (E2024 in épée), Andersen (C2024 in épée), and Benjamin H. (E2024 in épée).

The Metro Tacoma Fencing Club President's Award for the 2023-2024 season again goes to Gabey. He finished the season with 2922 points. These in-house points calculated for our own fencers are calculated based on the number of opponents a fencer finished ahead of plus 1 for each event. Gabey finished above 2891 opponents this season. Wow!

The Metro Tacoma Fencing Club Tenacity Award for the 2023-2024 season goes to Christopher who competed at 34 events which is more than anyone else this season. Last year he competed at 39 events.

Coach Toby earned his Master in Épée certification from the US Fencing Coaches Association. Fencing master is the highest level of certification and are described as "qualified to teach all levels of fencers as well as fencing coaches." There are currently 49 certified fencing Masters in foil and 49 certified fencing Masters in épée. Metro Tacoma Fencing Club has one Master in foil (Coach Chung) and now one Master in épée.

Gabey earned his Assistant Moniteur in foil certification this year. And Christopher will be submitting his application for the Assistant Moniteur certification after helping tonight in class with Coach Kim. According to the US Fencing Coaches Association, Assistant Moniteurs are qualified to assist all levels of professional coaches.

### Schedule changes

The biggest schedule change starting August 1 is that open fencing will be on Monday and Wednesday starting at 7:30 PM rather than Tuesday and Thursday. All members are welcome to open fencing and participate.

### The new fencing season

Please remember to renew your USA Fencing membership which is required for your continued participation in the next season starting August 1. Go to usafencing.org then to the "membership" section. An "Access" membership is required for classes and private lessons as well as for local competitions. "Competitive" memberships are required for fencers wishing to compete at regional, national, or international competitions.

We have lockers for rent for the season so you do not need to bring you entire fencing bag to and from the club every time you have a class. The cost is \$120 for the season (until 31 July 2025). I have my blades, body cords, and shoes in my locker. I just bring a duffle bag to and from the club with my fencing jacket and underarm protector so I can wash it after practice. It is very rare for anyone who is not a professional to compete against the best, but that is something that is possible in fencing. A high school team would never have the opportunity to play basketball against LeBron James and the LA Lakers. However, if you earn a C or higher rating and compete at a North American Cup (NAC) division 1 (open) national event, you might have the opportunity to have a past Olympian or a future Olympian in your pool round or a direct elimination round. My kids have had that chance with fencing. I fenced a former Olympian at Summer Nationals just a few weeks ago. It is quite the treat.
