Minors at Metro Tacoma Fencing Club (MTFC) Policy

Children 9 years old and under must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times. If you are unable to remain with your child during class, please designate another parent or adult to be responsible for your child during class. This minimizes disruption to the entire class if any issues should arise.

Children 10 years old and older may be dropped off for private lessons, classes, and Coach Led Open Fencing as long as there are at least two coaches already present in the building. These children may not be unattended in the building outside of class, lesson, or scheduled open fencing times.

Children 13 years old and older may be dropped off for lessons and classes as long as there are at least two coaches already present in the building. They may also wait in the building between lessons and classes. They must be respectful of club staff and property at all times. Also, please respect quiet time in the multi-purpose room (MPR), as many students study in there. These young adults are expected to clean up after themselves. If there are repeated issues with an unsupervised youth fencer, this privilege may be suspended for that fencer.

For this policy, the main building and annex are considered to be the same location. If you are in one part of the building and your child is in another part of the building, that is acceptable. However, there are times that parents will be required to be in the annex during their child's class or lesson to make sure we are in compliance with the Safe Sport policy requiring two unrelated adults when children are present.
